Tournament Rules and Regulations

Dress Code

We ask that all participants (organizers, players and volunteers) wear the proper golf attire on the golf course and in the clubhouse.

Acceptable Attire

Gentlemen:

- Slacks
- Jeans that do not have holes or frays
- Bermuda and walking length shorts
- Shirts must have sleeves

Ladies:

- Slacks or Capri pants
- Jeans that do not have holes or frays
- Bermuda and walking length shorts
- Shirts must have a collar or sleeves

Unacceptable Attire

- Sweat pants, track suits, bathing suits, "short" shorts
- Tank tops, muscle shirts, cut-off shirts, halter or strapless tops
- Footwear: Running shoes, casual shoes and golf sandals are permitted.

Power Carts and Rental Clubs:

Players will be advised of course conditions and obey the cart rules set out on the tournament date. Use of the cart paths whenever possible is greatly appreciated. Unfortunately over the past few years damage to rental equipment has become a problem. Because of this, all tournaments with rented power carts &/or clubs will be responsible for damage to these items. We will attempt to hold individuals responsible, however, if unsuccessful, the tournament will be held responsible.

Golf Course Etiquette:

Players are asked to repair ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers. All power and pull carts are to be kept off tee boxes and greens. Please respect the other golfers and refrain from the use of profanities on the the golf course.

Food and Beverage:

Due to MLCC liquor dispensing laws, all alcohol must be supplied by the John Blumberg Golf Course.

Pace of Play:

Slow play is still the #1 problem at most golf clubs today. In group outings, there is often a mix of “avid golfers” and “novice golfers”, so we have taken the appropriate steps to help avoid slow play.

Our marshals have been instructed to enforce the following rules:

- be **READY** to hit when it is your turn.
- **AVOID** taking excessive practice swings.
- **KEEP PACE** with the group ahead of you.
- **PACE OF PLAY** should not take more than an average of **15** minutes per hole.
- **ALL TOURNAMENTS** will play a Texas Scramble format unless authorized by the Head Golf Professional.

John Blumberg Golf Course - Tournament Policy Sheet

Thank you for selecting John Blumberg Golf Course for your next company or group tournament. We would like to draw your attention to the following requirements for hosting an event at our facility:

1. Any group with 20 people or more is considered a tournament and must abide by our tournament booking procedures.
2. All SHOTGUN START tournaments MUST include a banquet meal.
3. All tournaments MUST abide by regulations pertaining to food and alcohol consumption on the golf course. NO SPONSORED FOOD OR ALCOHOL WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE GOLF COURSE WITHOUT WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE MANAGEMENT
4. **Shotgun start tournaments** have special requirements.
5. All tournaments are required to supply a list of player grouping. Final confirmation and tee sheets are required NO LATER THAN 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT DATE; failure to do so may end up in additional charges due to lost revenue for the golf club. Golf cart booking will be confirmed with all tee sheet requirement.
6. Please encourage all of your players to call ahead to the Pro Shop to reserve their carts for the date of your tournament. We have access to an endless supply of power carts, but not at the last minute.
7. A DEPOSIT OF \$250 (\$500 for Shotgun Events) is required to hold the date of your tournament. Balance of total cost will be due on the tournament day. Any special request for payment terms must be made with John Blumberg Golf Course prior to the tournament date.

DEPOSIT WILL BE FORFEITED IF THE EVENT IS CANCELLED WITHOUT A MINIMUM OF TWO WEEKS NOTICE PRIOR TO SCHEDULED DATE UNLESS DATE IS RE-BOOKED WITH ANOTHER FUNCTION

8. A course marshal will be on duty at all times. Slow play will not be tolerated. It will also be expected of all golfers to exercise proper etiquette and decorum at all times. Failure to comply may result in warnings and possible expulsion from the premises.
9. A dress code is in effect. Please submit the proper dress code information to all of your players to avoid causing any embarrassment.
10. The club is not responsible for any damage or loss of any articles left in the club prior, during or after any function.
11. All Tournaments are responsible for any damage to the premises by his/her guests or independent contractors.

Food & Beverage Requirements

All food & beverage served at John Blumberg Golf Course is to be provided by the Course.

All food & beverage is subject to P.S.T., G.S.T. and a 15% gratuity.

A Guaranteed number of guests are required 48 hours before the function.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

The John Blumberg Golf Course reserves the right to bill for a total number of plates requested for banquet meals, unless changed prior to 48 hours of the function.
